

HORSE RIDING AT THE KENILWORTH GREENWAY

(A Permissive Bridleway only)

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Permits and ambands are issued subject to Warwickshire County Council's right to cancel them immediately in the event of any breach of regulations by the holder.
2. **Riders are only permitted to use the permissive bridleway route and must keep off the surfaced track.**
3. Failure to keep to the bridleway may lead to your permit being withdrawn.
4. The council reserves the right to close any section, or all, of The Greenway.
5. Horse riding is permitted only during the hours of daylight.
6. No cantering or galloping.
7. You must have your own public liability insurance with at least £2,000,000 cover.
8. You must wear your amband and carry your permit with you whenever you are riding at the site and it must be produced when requested by a member of Countryside Recreation staff.
9. Please note that cyclists, dog walkers and pedestrians also use this permissive bridleway and use must be with due care for other users.
10. Permits and ambands are non-transferable.
11. The council accepts no liability for loss of or damage to property resulting directly or indirectly from the granting of a permit.
12. The council reserves the right to close the bridleway to horse riders in poor ground conditions. If in doubt, please ring on 01827 872660 before visiting
13. A key will issued with your permit upon receipt of a £10.00 refundable deposit. This key is strictly for access to The Kenilworth Greenway by the permit holders only.
